

ACT and SAT Test

Deadlines announced Students interested in taking the October 25, 2014 ACT test must register on or before September 19th, 2014 in order to avoid late fees. Students may register online at www.actstudent.org or pick up an application in the high school counselor's office. The cost of the ACT test is \$38.00 or \$54.50, if a student registers for the ACT Plus Writing test. If someone is unsure which test to sign up for, please consult the high school counselor.

Students interested in taking the October 11, 2014 SAT Test must register on or before September 12th in order to avoid late fees. Another test is offered at Bronte High School in October, April and Free study guides are June. available in the counselor's office. The high school library has practice test preparation books available to students. The ACT and SAT websites also have free practice items available online. for the Service Academies Congressman Michael Conaway encourages all students interested in attending the military service academies to apply for nomination.

То be considered for appointment to a service academy, an applicant must meet eligibility requirements and be nominated by an authorized person, including a member of the U.S. Senate or U.S. House of Representatives. There are five service academies: The United States Air Force Academy, Naval, Military, Merchant Marine, and Coast Guard.

The application process for the class of 2019 is open. All applications must be received at Congressman Conaway's San Angelo office by October 22, 2014. The address for his San Angelo office is 33 East Twohig Ave., Suite 307, San Angelo, TX, 76903. The telephone number is 325 659-4010.

Please find the application at Conaway.house.gov or call or write his San Angelo office to have one sent to you.

The eligibility requirements for an applicant include: United States citizenship; a resident of the 11th District and at least 17-years-old but not older than 22 on July 1, 2015, on the year of admission. Selection is based on SAT and Act test scores, class rank, grade point average, extracurricular activities, and leadership potential.
