

Ty completed one pass on one attempt to McGinnis for another touchdown.

The Horns at times blocked very well, but still need to work on fundamentals and adjusting to different defenses and blocking rules.

The Horns had 323 yards rushing and 20 passing overall.

Defensively, the Horns gave up 160 yards on the ground and another 123 through the air. At the 6:41 mark of the 4th quarter, Ty found McGinnis in the left corner of the endzone and Nathan made a great catch for a 20 yard touchdown. The PAT was blocked and closed out the scoring for the evening and gave the Horns the 33-20 victory.
