County Commissioners meetings detailed

August 23, 2021

The Coke County Commissioners Court met in regular session at 9 am on Monday, August 23, 2021, at the Courthouse in Robert Lee.In attendance were County Judge Hal Spain, Commissioner Precinct 1 Donald Robertson, Commissioner Precinct 2 Paul Williams, Commissioner Precinct 3 Marshall Millican, Commissioner Precinct 4 Joe Sefcik and County Clerk Monica Reyes.

A public hearing was held in regards to the 2021-2022 proposed budget for Coke County. No citizens attended the hearing and it was closed at 9.15 am.

A public hearing was held in regards to the 2021-2022 proposed tax rate for Coke County. No citizens attended the hearing and it was closed at 9.25 am.

The meeting was opened with the pledge to the flag and prayer was offered by Judge Spain.

Judge Spain announced the presence of a quorum with all present.

No changes were made to the 2021-2022 budget.

Commissioner Millican made a motion that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 0.464776/\$100, which effectively a 3.5% increase in the tax rate for the fiscal year 2021-2022 Commissioner Sefcik seconded the motion. The motion carried. A roll call vote was conducted to approve the order adopting the overall property tax rate. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to adopt the general tax rate of .357527/\$100 valuation for the fiscal year 2021-2022. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion. The motion carried. A roll call vote was conducted to

approve the order adopting the tax rate. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Sefcik made a motion to adopt the Road & Bridge tax rate of .107249/\$100 valuation for the fiscal year 2021-2022. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted to approve the order adopting the Road & Bridge tax rate. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Robertson made a motion to adopt the General budget for the fiscal year 2021-2022. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted to approve the order adopting the 2021-2022 General budget. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Millican made a motion to adopt the Road & Bridge budget for the fiscal year 2021-2022. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted to approve the order adopting the Road & Bridge budget for 2021-2022. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to adopt the salaries as presented for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. Commissioner Sefcik seconded the motion. The motion carried.
