Roberts honored as Adult Silver Clover Leader

Texas AgriLife Extension Service's annual Silver Clover Recognition Banquet celebrated its 44th year August 11 in San Angelo. This year's event recognized 28 individuals who are instrumental to the success of AgriLife Extension's West Central District 4-H youth program. The leader honored from Coke County was Douglas Roberts. Douglas has been a volunteer 4-H leader for more than 17 years.

"Top volunteers are the backbone of all successful 4-H programs," said Garrett Gilliam. "They put in countless hours of work helping 4-H members become successful."

"The 4-H youth program offers a variety of projects, activities and events tailored specifically to support and enhance volunteer participation and involvement in kids' lives," he said. "This is our time as AgriLife Extension agents to show them the appreciation they deserve."

Gilliam said each county selects nominees who are then chosen by a committee comprised of area electric cooperative personnel and AgriLife Extension officials. The banquet is sponsored by the rural electric cooperatives serving the 23 counties in AgriLife Extension's District 7 in West Central Texas.

Coke County 4-H seeks members

The Coke County Extension agents will be conducting 4-H meetings in Bronte and Robert Lee to kick off the 4-H year. Any youth who is either 9 years old or 8 years old and in the 3rd grade, and has not reached their 19th birthday by August 31, 2011, is eligible to become a 4-H member. Meetings in Robert Lee will be held the first Wednesday of the month beginning September 7, 2011. The senior 4-H group, grades

7-12, will meet during the lunch period at the Catholic Church hall and the junior 4-H group, grades 3-6 will meet after school in the cafeteria. Bronte 4-H meetings will be held the 2nd Wednesday of the month, beginning September 14, 2011. Grades 3-6 will meet after school in the library, grades 7-12 will meet during the lunch period at the Bronte Church of Christ annex.

4-H is open to any youth regardless of sex, religion, race, socio-economic level, color, disability, or national origin, who meet the age requirements listed above. Individuals with disabilities, who require an auxiliary aid, service or accommodation in order to participate in these meetings, are encouraged to contact the Coke County Extension office at (325) 453-2461 to determine how reasonable accommodations can

Being a member of 4-H offers vast opportunities to gain valuable experience in leadership, learning responsibility, inter-action with others and knowledge in several project areas. Many people have the misconception that 4-H members only learn to cook, sew or have livestock projects, but 4-H is "more than just cooking and cows." Youth can participate in project areas including: gardening, horticulture, electricity, shooting sports, archery, government, wildlife, dog care and training, poultry and numerous other learning experiences. Through project work, being on judging teams, public speaking, method demonstrations and other 4-H areas, youth can learn valuable lessons in responsibility, being able to think for themselves, be able to speak in front of groups and other beneficial lessons to

help them in their lives later on. Also, 4-H is not just for youth—adults and parents are encouraged to become involved as volunteer leaders to assist in club meetings and various project groups.

Beginning this year, as part of the Extension Service's "Partial Cost Recovery Initiative", each 4-H member will be REQUIRED to pay a yearly \$20 membership fee.

All members must register by September 30, 2011. If

you are not registered before October 1, fees will increase to \$25. 4-H members may sign up at any time, however on Monday, September 12, agents will be at the Coke county courthouse from 4-6 p.m and on Tuesday, September 20, agents will be at City Hall in Bronte from 4-6 p.m. 4-H members must be a paid member to participate in any 4-H program or activity. You may also come by the Extension office Monday-Thursday 8-5, Friday 8-1 to register and pay enrollment fee.
