

The Longhorns ended the night with 314 yards of total offense while only giving up 153 yards of total offense to the Lions. Isaiah Ornelaz led the team in rushing with 185 yards and three touchdowns. Samuel Dominguez contributed to the Longhorns offense with 94 yards receiving and one touchdown reception. The Longhorns defense forced five turnovers. Tanner Bedford had a pair of interceptions, while Diego Perez, Tristin Minjarez, and Justin Reed each recovered a fumble. The Longhorns'next game will be against the TLCA Eagles on Friday September 2, at 7:30 pm in Bronte.

The following week took the Lady Longhorns on the road again Tuesday to Sonora for a dual with Sonora and Center Point. It was a Lady Longhorn Lady sweep! The Varsity Longhorns then competed in the Vannoy Memorial Nita Tournament in San Angelo. All three matches were won in straight sets. The end of the week brought the 16th Annual "Showdown" Tournament for the Varsity girls. They finished with a silver medal to district rival Water Valley.

The Varsity Lady Longhorns currently have an overall record of 15-7.
