meeting minutes

The Coke County Commissioners met in special session on August 22, 2017, at 9 am in the courthouse in Robert Lee. Those in attendance included County Judge Roy Blair, Commissioner Precinct #1 Donald Robertson, Commissioner Precinct #2 Paul Williams, Commissioner Precinct #3 Marshall Millican, Commissioner Precinct #4 Joe Sefcik and Clerk Mary Grim.

The meeting was opened with the pledge to the flag and prayer was offered by Judge Blair.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.

Judge Blair opened the Public Hearing regarding the 2017-2018 proposed budget and tax rate for Coke County. There were fourteen (14) people in attendance.

Judge Blair asked for any comments. There being none, Judge Blair adjourned the meeting at 9:06 am.

Commissioner Millican moved to approve the minutes for August 8th and 18th. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sefcik. The motion carried.

Judge Blair reported that the burn ban is off. No action was taken.

County Clerk Mary Grim presented the Court with a list of names for appointments. Commissioner Williams moved to appoint the Election Judges and Alternates as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robertson. The motion carried.

Commissioner Williams moved to support the Brontetoberfest and park reservations at no charge. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion carried.

Commissioner Williams moved to approve the Interlocal Agreement for Rural Transit Services with the Concho Valley Transit District. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robertson. The motion carried.

Commissioner Sefcik moved to approve the Line Item Transfers as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams. The motion carried.

Commissioner Williams requested that they be able to move excess equipment for auction to Precinct 1.

Commissioners Robertson and Millican reported on the damage from recent storm to the show barn.

Judge Blair reported that Senator Charles Perry will hold a town hall meeting September 6th at 5:00 in the large rec hall, getting bid on repairing sidewalk, brick repairs and flooring in Commissioners' Courtroom.

Treasurer Hal Spain reported that Rollie with TAC will hold a Human Resources Workshop September 21st for all elected officials in the County Courtroom.

There being no private road work requests, no action was taken.

Commissioner Robertson moved to pay bills. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sefcik. The motion carried.
