ECCHD board meetings minutes told

August 17, 2020 Special Meeting

The East Coke County Hospital District Board of Directors met for a special meeting on Monday, August 17, 2020, at 4 pm in the patio area of the Bronte Health and Rehab Center. President Howard Baker presided over the meeting. Other board members present were Everett Bedford, Lanette Fletcher, and Gina McCutchen. Jerita Taylor was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 4 pm.

A quorum was established.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive comments from Bronte Health and Rehab Center employees on ways to improve employee work and improve services to our residents.

One employee attended to visit with the board.

The meeting was adjourned and the board moved to Bronte City Hall for the regular meeting scheduled there for 5 pm.

August 17, 2020 Regular Meeting

The East Coke County Hospital District Board of Directors met for a regular meeting on Monday, August 17, 2020, at 5 pm at Bronte City Hall. President Howard Baker presided over the meeting. Other board members present were Everett Bedford, Lanette Fletcher, and Gina McCutchen. Administrator Daisy Toms, Chief Financial Officer Johnny Mathis, and Business Office Manager Fran Sonnenberg were also present. Jerita Taylor was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 5 pm.

A quorum was established.

Prayer was led by Everett

Bedford.

There were no public comments.

The minutes of the July 20, 2020, and July 27, 2020, meetings were reviewed. Lanette Fletcher moved that the minutes be approved as presented and was seconded by Gina McCutchen. The motion carried unanimously.

Lanette Fletcher moved that the 2020 tax rate be set at \$0.350057 per \$100 evaluation, which is the same as last year's rate. The first public hearing will be set for Tuesday, September 1, 2020, and the second public hearing for Tuesday, September 8, 2020. Both hearings will be at 5 pm. Gina McCutchen seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The Director of Nurses' Report was not available since there is not a Director of Nurses at the present time.

Ms. Toms gave the Administrator's Report and reported that we have 32 residents at this time. A part-time Social Services Worker was hired today. We are currently working with four different agencies for staffing.

Mr. Mathis gave the Chief Financial Officer's Report and distributed updated Accounts Receivable Aging Reports, as well as Financial Statements through July 31.

The board reviewed the bank statements and petty cash reconciliation. The credit card statement had not been received as of the meeting time.

The board reviewed all bills that have been paid.

The board moved from the regular meeting to executive session at 5:43 pm.

The board left executive session and returned to regular session at 6:17 pm. Everett Bedford moved to (1) approve the additional compensation to nursing staff for extra shifts of 4 hours minimum and for nursing department scheduling, (2) offer two different health plans to employees, (3) meet with attorney Ken Slimp at a special called executive meeting on August 24 at 5 pm at City Hall, and (4) to meet the next two months at City Hall. The motion was seconded by Gina McCutchen. The motion carried unanimously.

Everett Bedford moved that the meeting be adjourned at 6:18 pm. Gina McCutchen seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

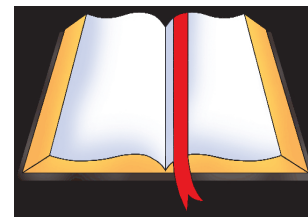
