The Bronte ISD Board of Trustees held a regularly scheduled board meeting on June 11, 2020. Those in Board attendance were Blake Braswell, Members Ashley Braswell, John Seales, Jodie Arrott, David McWright, Terry Queen, Administration members Tim Siler and Doug Kuhlmann, and guest Rebecca

The meeting was opened at 7:01 pm with a prayer by Blake Braswell.

A quorum was established with five members present. Terry Queen arrived at 7:44

There were no audience items.

The minutes for the regular May meeting and special meeting on May 21, 2020 were presented and read. A motion to approve as presented was made by David McWright and seconded by Jodie Arrott. Ayes: 5, Nayes: 0. The motion

Mrs. Siler advised the current wireless system has major problems including unsatisfactory support from the current service. She obtained a quote from Response Service International to repair/replace wireless access ports, along with three years of support. The SRSA grant will help pay for this system. Ashley Braswell made a motion to approve and was seconded by David McWright. Ayes: 5, Nayes: 0. The motion passed.

Jodie Arrott made a motion, seconded by John Seales, to approve Rebecca Siler as the designee to report compliance. Ayes: 5, Nayes: 0. The motion passed.

Superintendent's Report Mr. Siler gave an update on school finances. An extractor (carpet shampooer) was recently purchased. Mr. Siler is unsure how the year will end. The State will fund ADA off of 2/3 of the school year and will estimate the other 1/3 using a formula based off the 5th 6 weeks. Mr. Siler is looking into

grants including those from the Federal Government through the CARES Act. He is not comfortable giving any figure on how year will end with so much up in the air.

There were budget amendments.

Changes were made to wording regarding the start of the school year being no earlier than August 1. Ashley Braswell made a motion to approve and was seconded by Jodie Arrott. Ayes: 5, Nayes: 0. The motion

Mr. Siler presented an updated calendar with built in remedial/enrichment days on the Friday after the end of every 6 weeks. David McWright made a motion to approve. Ashley Braswell seconded. Ayes: 6, Nayes: 0, Motion passed.

Jodie Arrott made a motion to continue with The Brokerage Store for student accident insurance and Terry Queen seconded. Ayes: 6, Nayes: 0. The motion passed.

The Board entered into executive (closed) session at 8 pm and came out at 8:09 pm.

Ashley Braswell made a motion to offer Sara Baxter a one-year probationary contract for band director for the 20-21 school year. Terry Queen seconded. Ayes: 6, Nayes: 0. The motion passed

The July Board meeting will be held on July 9, 2020 at 7 pm. Jodie Arrott made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by David McWright. The meeting adjourned at 8:12 p.m.
