


BRONTE SCHOOL NEWS

The Baird Bears defeated the Bronte Longhorns on Friday by a score of 26-14. The Bears scored once in the first quarter and once in the second quarter to take a 14-0 halftime lead.

At the three minute mark of the third quarter Josh Puentez scampered 17 yards for a TD and Lance Burns PAT trimmed the lead to 14-7. On the first play of the fourth quarter, the Bears scored on a 28 yard run to extend their lead to 20-7 but missed the PAT. At the five minute mark, Puentez scored from 5 yards out and the PAT was good to cut the lead to 20-14. That drive was set up by a blocked punt that was downed at the ten yard line. The Bears responded with a time consuming drive that would eventually score one more time with 1:09 to play to end the scoring for the evening.

With the win Baird, improved

to 2-2 on the season and the Horns fell 0-4.
