Bronte Council enacts new ordinances regulating animals

At a Bronte City Council meeting earlier this month, the council voted into law two new ordinances regulating animals, livestock and fowl within the Bronte city limits. Many Bronte citizens are very unhappy with this ordinance and have requested the ordinance be revised, if not rescinded, at the October council meeting. In addition, the ordinances state that they will be enforced by the Coke County Sheriff's Department. The Coke County Sheriff's "Office" is not in the employ of the City of Bronte and therefore does not enforce the City's ordinances. The City of Bronte and the City of Robert Lee each contract with the deputies, as individuals, to enforce their ordinances.

Due to their length, there is no way to print the entire ordinances. In the Classified section of this issue, there are short Public Notices for each of these ordinances. They are available to the public in their entirety at the ObserverEnterprise.com. However, a few excerpts have been included from the livestock ordinance which may be the basis for the citizens' anger.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep livestock within the corporate city limits of the City of Bronte, Texas unless you have (1.00) acre or more of land, and all livestock animals must be confined to a designated premise for grazing purposes.
