To provide advice and professional recommendations to the City of Bronte, Texas ("the City") for capital financing and provide assistance with possible loan, grant or disadvantaged funding through the Texas Water Development Board's ("TWDB") Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") and Clean Water State Revolving Fund ("CWSRF").

## A. INTENT OF PROPOSAL

The City is soliciting Request for Proposals ("RFP") and Statement of Qualifications from interested qualified professionals to provide: strategic financial planning; analysis of market conditions; recommended investments of bond proceeds; and provide recommendations to the City for financing through programs established by TWDB. The City seeks to afford the opportunity for qualified SBE, MBE, and WBE firms to propose to provide the services described herein.
