Those present included Mayor Jason Moran; and Council Members Tracy Grantham, Josh Tennison, David Lewis, Jonathan Torres, and Daniel Jasso.

The call to order was held, a quorum was determined, and the meeting was declared open at 6:54 pm.

Discussion was held regarding a construction proposal submitted by a potential contractor to finish construction to City Hall. The City Attorney recommends writing a letter of termination to previous contractor. The new proposal would be \$6300 for labor and materials. A motion was made by Jonathan Torres to approve of the construction proposal and

allow the mayor to oversee and approve of the contract, with the stipulation that it has a start and completion date on the contract. He was seconded by Daniel Jasso and the motion carried with a vote of 5 - 0.

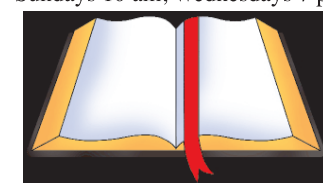
