The Coke County Appraisal District will hold a public hearing on a proposed budget for the 2022 fiscal year.

The public hearing will be held on September 14, 2021, at 5:30 pm at the Coke County Courthouse, second floor jury room.

\$5,900.00 of the increase from last year is due to the state mandate for a new website for tax rate information transparency and also the requirement for the Appraisal District to mail a postcard to every taxpayer on the appraisal roll introducing the new website.

If approved by the appraisal district board of directors at the public hearing, this proposed budget will take effect automatically unless disapproved by the governing bodies of the county, school districts, cities and towns served by the appraisal district.
