Senior Ethan Andrews carried the ball for 11 yards and Senior Oakley Anderson caught 1 pass for 6 yards.

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The COKE COUNTY conducted public hearings on August 23, 2013 and September 3, 2013 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the COKE COUNTY from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.31 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.543447 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$1,890,488.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.504831 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,982,062.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.504831 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,993,428.

The Coke County of COKE COUNTY is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 16, 2013 at Coke County Courthouse, Commissioner's Courtroom, 13 E 7th, Robert Lee, Texas at 9:00 AM.
