Such a Shame! Most of the beautiful old trees at the Coke County Park in Bronte have died. The park is owned by Coke County and they employ a park caretaker for the Bronte Park. According to John Barnett, park caretaker, the trees were lost due to the drought and not disease. When contacted, Bronte City Secretary Pat Martindale explained that until recently Bronte had not been under any water restrictions - at least not during the time the trees became stressed. These trees are now a danger to anyone standing under or around them because of the brittleness of the dead limbs.
